“Who am I looking for?”

Faithful, Available, Teachable

Questions to ask if someone isn't following through on the obedience/sharing: (GOAL is to AFFIRM!)

- How are you feeling now that you told us?
- Do you feel like we are all judging you right now?
- How can we help you take a next step?
- Pray for that person.
- No matter what, point out growth in each person and how it will help them grow as a group!

TIPS:

- As a leader, you are a detective...What is really going on? How can you help each person take one step forward? How can we help each other get unstuck?
- There are no passengers in a discipleship group. EVERYONE plays a part; not just the leader.
- Don't let one person share too much. You want everyone to have a chance to share so that they have a chance to grow.
- After 2-3 weeks of facilitating your group, start having the people take turns facilitating each week. (This is so they can build confidence in leading a group on their own while you are present.)

7 DNA Characteristics of a Confident Carrier of the Gospel

- **LIVE** in the freedom and identity of Jesus—train others to do the same
- **READ, UNDERSTAND, and OBEY** God's word—train others to do the same
- **PRAY** on your own and with others—train others to do the same
- **THRIVE** in a community of Christ followers - train others to do the same
- **COMMUNICATE** Gospel with anyone - train others to do the same
- **SEE** where the Kingdom is not yet—train others to do the same
- **FOLLOW** Jesus no matter what the cost—train others to do the same

Coaching Questions:

LOOK BACK (to how your group went this past week)

***Did you follow through on your obedience step(s) since we last met?**

What is going really well? Are you getting to each THIRD?

What challenges are coming up?

Was there anything that caught you off guard?

Are you seeing the 7 DNA characteristics being integrated? How can you make sure the people in your group are growing in them?

LOOK UP (your personal growth in Christ)

How have you personally been abiding in Christ and growing in relationship with him?

How have you taken opportunities to serve or bless others who are different than you?

Have you seen specific answers to prayer?

Ask 1 or 2 of these questions each time you meet:

- Have you been having any jealous or comparison behavior?
- Have you given in to an addictive, or lazy, or undisciplined behavior?
- Have you been exposed to sexually alluring material, or allowed your mind to entertain inappropriate sexual thoughts?
- Have you failed to forgive someone?
- What worries or anxieties are you facing? Have you complained or grumbled? Have you maintained a thankful heart?

LOOK FORWARD (to your group these coming weeks)

What questions do you have for me?


What are your highest priorities for this next week?

***What concrete steps will you take this next week?**






